

GOD STILL HAS A PURPOSE FOR YOU

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Psalm 139:16

Your life is not an accident. You were created by God with intentionality, purpose, and destiny. Even when life takes unexpected turns and our choices lead us away from His path, God's purposes are not cancelled.

Everything about you matters to God. Your gifts, passions, abilities, personality, and even the experiences that have shaped your journey can all become part of His purpose for your life.

But knowing that God has a purpose is only the beginning. We must discover how He has uniquely made us, choose to align our lives with His will, and return to Him whenever we wander from His path.

1. **DISCOVER – You Are God's Unique Masterpiece**

"For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them." Ephesians 2:10 (ESV)

There is no one else exactly like you. Jesus uniquely formed you—not merely to exist, but to walk in the good works He has prepared for you. Stop comparing yourself with others or trying to become someone you were never created to be. **Your uniqueness is part of God's design.** Ask Him to show you how your gifts and experiences can become channels of His purpose.

2. **CHOOSE – Align Your Life With God's Will**

"Seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you." Matthew 6:33 (ESV)

God has a purpose for your life, but He does not force you to fulfil it. **Your destiny is shaped by the choices you make.** We can pursue pleasure, popularity, position, possessions, or God's Kingdom. Jesus asks:

"For what does it profit a man to gain the whole world and forfeit his soul?" Mark 8:36 (ESV)

The greatest success is not achieving your own plans—it is aligning your life with God's purpose.

3. **REALIGN – It Is Never Too Late to Return**

"In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths." Proverbs 3:6 (ESV)

Perhaps you have made mistakes, taken wrong turns, or wandered off to your own path. But **God still has a purpose for you.** When we turn back to Him and surrender our ways, God can redirect our steps. He can bring purpose out of painful experiences and use even broken chapters as part of a greater story.

Your past may have affected your journey, but it does not have the final word. **God's grace can realign you with His purpose. GOD STILL HAS A PURPOSE FOR YOU.**
